**THANK YOU!** Thanks to our customers, 2004 was another busy year. The amount of feed processed was nearly 200 more ton than in '03. Customers are from the local area and some come from 150 miles and more to get feed or seed. Bulk feed is delivered to as far as 150 miles from the Mill.

Customers have told us that their chicken broilers have had fewer leg problems and lower mortality with our feed. Some customers have requested a higher protein percentage, especially for grazing birds. We are sending more grains in to be tested for the protein level and this year we are revising the feed rations to increase the protein level by 1% for our chicken starter and grower feed. We continue to strive for improved quality for feed and seed.

### SPRING PLANTING —

- Seed available - certified organic and non-gmo/non-treated. The list includes Buckwheat (Manor), Oats-regular (Ebeltoft), Hulless (Buff), Spring Wheat (Gunnar & Parshall) and Hairy Vetch.

- Fertilizers—Greensand, Rock Phosphate and Alfalfa Meal.

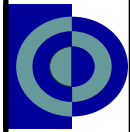

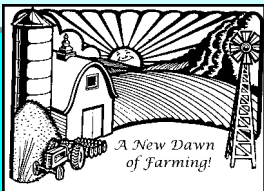
